 - Morning (8:00 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.)
 - Evening (3:00 p.m. - 10:30 p.m.)
 - Overnight (10:00 p.m. - 6:30 a.m.)

HIGHEST NEED IS EVENING, OVERNIGHT, and WEEKEND SHIFTS.

NOTES: Spanish-speaking volunteers are strongly preferred, but not required. Those who are pregnant or have compromised immune systems are advised not to volunteer.
