Currently, we are working with City staff in preparation for the joint Fall Brown Bag session in conjunction with RECOSA's Annual Meeting on **November 17** at 11:30 a.m. **Mayor Ron Nirenberg** has accepted RECOSA's invitation to be our guest speaker discussing San Antonio as an age-friendly community, as well as current topics of interest. HR has booked a great venue for us at the Phil Hardberger Urban Ecology Center. TUNEIN TO YOUR Annual Enrollment is here! This is your chance to change your medical plan for the 2024 plan year, which begins on January 1. Health Care premiums can be found in the Benefit Matters Guide along with more details about your

plans and other benefits. You can also view the guide online at sanantonio.gov/ EmployeeInformation/RetiredEmployees.

In 2024, our medical, dental and vision providers will remain the same—Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Texas (pre-65 retirees), Aetna (post-65 retirees), Humana Dental, and VSP.

This year, information sessions about your health plan options will once again be held virtually. Below is information about how to join these meetings online or by phone from the comfort of your home. Feel free to invite a family member or anyone who helps you with your health care decisions to join.

#### **Pre-65 Retirees**

Dates: Annual Enrollment is occurring now through October 31, 2023. Information Session: An online information session will be hosted by the Employee Benefits team via WebEx. The WebEx will feature a presentation and an opportunity for you to ask questions. This WebEx will also be recorded and posted on the HR website at sanantonio.gov/EmployeeInformation/RetiredEmployees.
