Words on RECOSA—A Note From the Chair

RECOSA appreciates the opportunity to welcome you to a new year with renewed commitment to stay healthy, connected, and informed.

On November 17, 2023, RECOSA and the City's Department of Human Resources held a combined fall Brown Bag/ Annual Membership meeting featuring remarks by Mayor Ron Nirenberg, an election for four open positions on the 2024 Board, the first-ever silent auction, and over 40 donated "door prizes" to over 100 attendees. RECOSA appreciates the continued support of the HR staff for our activities.

During the Annual Meeting, the Nominating Committee (Liz Garcia, Chair; Rebecca Waldman; and David Lopez) submitted a slate of four candidates for consideration for the 2024 Board: two current board members, Stephen Haney, and Kevin Burton; a former board member, Frank Villani; and a new board member, Steve DeLaHaya. There were no nominations from the floor and the slate of candidates was elected by acclamation.

RECOSA's 2023 Annual Report has been completed and is available for review on RECOSA's website (www.recosa.org). Also, the Board continues to plan and develop the topics for the 2024 Brown Bag Sessions around the recommendations from the 2022 RECOSA Survey. The first Brown Bag of 2024 will occur on March 22, 2024. Presentations will be made by the Alzheimer's Association and Methodist Health Care.

For 2024, the Board is proposing amendments to our Bylaws to facilitate the election of Board members and future changes to the Bylaws by making the process open to more RECOSA members who may not be able to attend

2024 RETIREE MATTERS

Health & Safety



Because regular dental and vision visits are a key part of maintaining your overall health, here are a few reminders of the benefits available to you if you are currently enrolled in dental and/or vision insurance with Humana Dental or Vision Service Plan (VSP). If you are not currently enrolled in either of these plans, but would like either

coverage, you may enroll during the annual enrollment period this coming October. Information about how to enroll will be mailed to your homes before annual enrollment begins.

DENTAL

The Humana PPO plan allows you to visit the dentist of your choice. In-network coverage includes:

- cleanings and oral exams covered at 100%;
- fillings, simple extractions, and periodontics covered at 80%; and
- bridges and dentures covered at 50%.

The Dental HMO plan requires that you select an in-network provider at the time of enrollment. Coverage includes:

- office visits, oral exams, x-rays, and two teeth cleanings per year with no co-pay;
- periodontal scaling and root planning at \$55 per quadrant;
- amalgam fillings at \$5 for one surface;
- surgical extractions at \$40;
- root canals at \$250; and
- crowns at \$270.

VISION

VSP provides access to thousands of private practice doctors and over 700 Visionworks retail locations nationwide. Coverage includes:

- annual WellVision exam for \$10;
- \$200 featured frame brands allowance, \$200 Visionworks frame allowance, \$150 frame allowance including Walmart/Sam's Club, 20% savings on the amount over your allowance, \$80 Costco frame allowance;
- single vision, lined bifocal, and lined trifocal lenses for no co-pay;
- \$150 allowance for contacts (instead of glasses); and
- retinal screening for members with diabetes, additional exams and services for members with diabetes, glaucoma, or age-related macular degeneration, treatment and diagnosis of eye conditions including pink eye, vision loss, and cataracts are \$20 per exam.

An additional benefit offered by VSP is a hearing health care plan that includes a discount of up to \$40 for hearing aids.
