

Volunteering at a City Department of Human Services Senior Center?

Earn credit toward your property tax bill!



SAVES (San Antonio Volunteer Exemption for Seniors)

This program allows homeowners to earn credit for their City of San Antonio portion of the property tax bill

Eligible applicants volunteering up to 56 hours can earn \$7.25/hour, for a benefit of \$406 for their annual property tax bill.

Requirements Include:

- Age 65 or older
- Registered as a user and volunteer with a Dept. of Human Services Comprehensive Senior Center
- Owner of a homestead property located in the City of San Antonio
- Does not currently have a mortgage loan or property tax escrow account associated with the property
- Has a Social Security number or IRS Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) that allows the participant to complete the required IRS W-4
